RULE SUMMARY

The temporary rules will clarify that the standard of substantial evidence required for a housing complaint is reasonable cause for the Commissioner to believe the facts concerning the alleged discriminatory housing practice are sufficient to warrant the initiation of a civil action in circuit court.

The temporary rules will clarify that complaints of discrimination in housing need not be signed by an unemancipated minor complainant, but must be signed by the minor's parent or legal guardian.
