Nominations may be submitted for one or more of the award categories:

Fair Workplace Champion – For businesses that show exceptional commitment to creating safe and healthy workplaces which provide living wage jobs.

Workforce Development Champion – For businesses that show exceptional commitment to the education, training and skill development of Oregon's workforce.

All nominations should clearly identify:

- The nominator and how to contact you
- The nominee, including a contact person and reliable contact information including the employer's website
- How the nominee has demonstrated leadership in its commitment to fair workplaces, protecting civil rights in the community and/or developing a stronger workforce
