Specific Project Work To Be Completed

Project work would be to perform maintenance on Roseburg District developed recreation trails. These trails are: North Umpqua, Sawmill, Emerald, Susan Creek Falls and Wolf Creek Falls Trails. Trail work could include: trail tread maintenance, brushing, de-watering the trails by constructing ditches or water bars or clearing of ditches and culverts, rerouting of trails around hazards, gravelling and construction of puncheons.

The crew would be needed in the spring after the winter blowdown and slides have occurred. In the past, they have worked on average, 2-3 days a week for 6-7 hours a day. Other project work would be to perform maintenance on Roseburg District developed recreation sites (8 campgrounds, 12 day-use areas). Work would include but not limited to; sanding, staining and rebuilding of picnic tables, weed eating and pulling, brushing, limbing of trees, leaf blowing and raking, debris removal, sand and gravel work, split rail fence installation, sign installation and trail maintenance including construction of new trails, gravelling and brushing . There could also be the need for special projects as they come up. In the past, they have included pheromone packet installation, campsite expansion and gate installations.

The crew would be needed as often as they are available and the work is there (most of the work is needed during the winter and spring months). Tools needed: polaskis, shovels, rakes, gloves, and ear and eye protection. Tools outside of these basics are provided by the BLM. Gas is not needed for power equipment. All district recreation trails are within a 45 minute drive.
