

Specific Project Work To Be Completed

Alesea Fall Trail Maintenance and Construction- Project site is located in Benton County, approximately 10 miles west of Alpine. The Alesea Falls area provides a mix of overnight camping, day use and trail activities including hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking. This project is in addition to the opportunity announcement posted in April 2013.

The projects calls for a minimum of 3 weeks of a supervised youth crews with between 6 and 10 members. Work will consist of trail maintenance, construction and enhancement. Work will be directed and overseen by BLM recreation staff in conjunction with contracted professional trail builders. Tasks may include grubbing, clearing, excavation and construction of retaining walls and other trail features. Work will take place Monday through Thursday or Friday, for a total of three weeks anytime between August 1st and October 30th, 2013. Scheduling of specific dates will be completed once a selection has been made.

Experience in the construction of non-motorized trails is preferred. The recipient is responsible for transportation to and from the job site.
