

Procedure for Resolving a Non-Criminal Allegation of a Violation of the Act, Regulations, Grant or Other Agreement Under the Workforce Investment Act filed Directly Against the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development

151-020-0045 (1) If there is a complaint against the Department (CCWD) and the complainant is a Local Workforce Area subrecipient, another grant recipient, or other entity receiving WIA funds directly from the Department, the initial complaint must be filed at the State level with CCWD.

(2) The Grievance procedure to be followed is the Contested Cases procedure as outlined in the Attorney General's most current Administrative Law Manual and Model Rules of Procedure Subsection IV.

(3) These procedures shall be used for the resolution of complaints arising from actions, such as audit disallowance or the imposition of sanctions, taken by the governor with respect to audit findings, investigations, or monitoring reports.
