



Criminal Justice Commission seeks nominations for **COMMUNITY BASED VICTIMS SERVICES PANELISTS**

The Criminal Justice Commission is recruiting Victims Services Advocates to review grant applications for the Justice Reinvestment Victims Services 10%. The Commission will select panelists based on their knowledge and experience in victims services, related fields, and in the community. Special attention will be given to ensure that the panelists reflect the demographics of the state with representation from various counties.

Grant panelists will be responsible for reading and reviewing applications three to four weeks prior to the panel meeting. They will attend two full-day meetings where the merits of each application for the Victims Services 10% are discussed with fellow panel members.

Grant panelist nominations must come from an Organization Director or Local Public Safety Coordinating Council (LPSCC) Chair. Nominees must have a minimum of 5 years experience working with crime victims.

If you know someone who might be interested in serving as a panelist, **please nominate them using this form**. The Commission will follow up with your nominee. While the number of nominations may exceed the number of available panelist positions, the Commission will retain all submissions for consideration in the future. Each nomination will contribute to a diverse pool to make panelist selections.
