COMMUNICATION DURING A DISASTER

To report an emergency: Call 911	If your phone does not work, try a neighbor's phone. If no working land line phone, try a cell phone.	
If no phone available	Go to a fire station and report the emergency.	
If life-threatening Medical emergency	Go directly to a hospital. Do not waste time trying to call for help.
