- Over 30% of people with disabilities in Oregon have college degrees?
- Nearly a third of people in Oregon with disabilities earn less than \$25,000 a year.
- The national poverty rate for people with disabilities in 2014 was over 28%.
- The national poverty rate for people without disabilities was only 13%.
