

Section 9 – Agency Specific Applications

Agencies Transporting Minors

The following conditions are recommended to transport minors in state vehicles:

- Activity must be part of official state business.
- A DAS order must be obtained for special occasions. See [OAR 125-155-420\(6\)\(c\)](#).
- A form must be signed by each minor's parent or guardian and received by your designee, to grant permission for the minor's participation in the program, to authorize emergency medical treatment in case of accident or illness, and to ride in a state vehicle. (This is not necessary for wards of the state.)
- An adequate number of child safety seats, or boosters and seat restraints are available for each child and the driver requires their use. If any children are uncooperative in using child safety seats, boosters, or seatbelts, consider having a chaperone monitor them so that they will not distract the driver.
