Agenda item VII - Working Group Discussion went beyond time allotment last 30 mins of the Agenda was spent on this topic.

Text below is paraphrased discussion, not verbatim.

Valeria A:

Want to start a discussion on the Working Group. Not sure we have every Early Learning sector covered by the TAC group itself. Who else should we include in this process? What does that look like?

Valerie S:

Maybe the TAC needs to hold a working session to help us decide what the working group should look like? TAC hasn't had time to bond, we still need to build relationships.

Sonya:

Tribes asked / advocated for their own tribal early learning hub. Val and Modesta advocated for this, sometimes that is getting lost in the work.

Modesta:

We are still at the consultation part of the process, the government-to-government part. Maybe the TAC doesn't want to speak to the tribal early learning hub at this point. Not sure if a working group or bringing in outside entities is really a direction we want to go? Confused on the process.

Valerie S:

Feeling rushed. Are we inviting the right people to this call? Tribal representation is enough. We have the 9 tribes, from the 18 are we going to choose the working group. Confused on the process.

Julie:

Willing to do what is in the best interest of the children. Even if that means giving more time.

Valeria A:

Maybe we can ask the questions on how we want to proceed over email and schedule time we need to discuss how best to move forward.
