

Emergency Engine Operation Notification (EEO)

Form R1009

Instructions: This form is provided for the notification of the operation of any backup power generation equipment during an emergency. This notification must be submitted to Oregon DEQ within 30 days of the emergency event, unless otherwise approved in writing by Oregon DEQ. Complete one form for each emergency operation event and submit to the appropriate DEQ office using the email listed below, emailing to the appropriate DEQ permit writer/ or facsimile.

Emergency situations are defined in 40 CFR 60 subparts IIII and JJJJ, and 40 CFR 63 subpart ZZZZ. Examples include stationary ICE used to produce power for critical networks or equipment (including power supplied to portions of a facility) when electric power from the local utility (or the normal power source, if the facility runs on its own power production) is interrupted, or stationary ICE used to pump water in the case of fire or flood, etc.
