## HUMAN HEALTH RISK BASED RULES WEBINAR

## POLICY FORUMS

At these forums to be held at four locations around the state, DEQ and OHA present policy topics followed by an opportunity for the public to provide comment to inform the Advisory Committee discussions.

October - December 2017

## PUBLIC NOTICE & COMMENT PERIOD

Opportunity for public comment on the draft rules and fiscal impact statement starting October 15. Comment can be submitted online or at one of several public hearings to be held in locations around the state.

December 2017 - April 2018

DEQ and OHA review and consider each public comment, publish them to the web, and may revise the draft rules and fiscal impact statement based on them. The agencies prepare a staff report with rule language, fiscal impact statement and responses to public comments for the Environmental Quality Commission.

June, July, 2016

## TECHNICAL WORKGROUP

This group of experts tackles the technical aspects of the rulemaking such as risk assessment and pollutant concentrations and provides an opportunity for the public to learn what informs and determines limits to guide the new rules.

October 2016–August 2017

## RULES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

This DEQ-appointed committee makes recommendations on the draft rules and fiscal impact statement based on public comment and the work of the Technical Workgroup and Policy Forums. These are public meetings with an open forum for public feedback.
