Year to Date Collections 12 years and counting

Over **7.5 million gallons** of paint collected

2021 Latex Paint-to-Paint Recycling

Held steady at 81%

As compared to 80% in 2021

From PaintCare's Annual Report:

Latex paint is sorted, blended and sometimes re-tinted into recycled-content latex paint for local use, as well as domestic or international use.

Collection Volumes as a Percentage, Statewide (2020-2021)

Year	Total (gallons)	Gallons per Capita	% Retail	% Solid Waste Infrastructure	% PaintCare Collection Events	% Large Volume User/Pick- up
2020	706,270	0.17	46.7	48.7	0.4	4.2
2021	740,102	0.17	47.3	46.8	0.3	5.6

5% increase in collection volume from 2021

Highlights of Estimated Paint Collection Volumes by Wasteshed (2021)

A wasteshed is defined in Oregon law as being an area of the state that shares a common solid waste disposal system. For most of Oregon, a wasteshed is an individual county except the Milton-Freewater and Metro wastesheds.

Highlights of Estimated Paint Collection Volumes by Wasteshed (2021)

- Roughly half of the amount collected (55%) came from the Metro wasteshed
- Deschutes (8%)
- Lane(8%)
- Marion (7%)

Highlights of Estimated Paint Collection Volumes by Wasteshed (2021)

Two wastesheds reported no collections

- Gilliam and Wheeler

One wasteshed without a permanent
collection site

- Gilliam

Highlights of Estimated Paint Collection Volumes by Wasteshed (2021)

- Almost half, 46%, of all wastesheds rely heavily or exclusively on the use of retail take back (16 of 35)
- Almost 30% (10 of 35) rely on solid waste infrastructure
