DV ITR ~ Concerns -

- Status of “intimate relationships” condition, most often a PPS condition or DVIC rules.
- Do people run LEDS on IRT’s? This seems to vary by county. LEDS would show S.O. registrations and RO’s . Are victims notified when the offender is planning a move? Add victim advocate’s name on 3rd page.

***** “No Contact order” Modification standards ~ we will be receiving an email asking for each counties guidelines.**

Earned Discharge – applies to anyone sentenced on or after 8/1/13, potentially could get off supervision once half of their supervision has been completed and requirements have completed.

*Linn Co. ~ Judges fighting it.

*Washington Co. ~ On probation cases – Judges order bench probation on offenders who are EDIS discharged from formal supervision.

*Lane Co. ~ Not doing it.

*Jefferson Co. ~ Eligible cases are terminating or moving to bench probation.

DV Academy ~ Jeff Hansen will send out a survey monkey asking about having another DV 101 and/or advanced topics.

County Updates ~

Washington County ~ Hiring 6 PPO's, 2 Case monitors. Chris Enquist is doing a presentation at Washington County on Hybrid caseloads. Dominic looking at having SO/DV caseload. Family Violence Intervention - CHOICES, Allies in Change offer

- Similar to anger management & parenting
- Victims are children /teens

Baker County ~ Baker has 3 FT PPO's and Director carries a caseload. They have 2 new DDA's and they are communicating with PPO's prior to sentencing. Judges pushing for a hearing each time for modifications of "No Contact". Non-Profit Advocacy Program – Attorney General took tour, PREA program component starting with Powder River.

Linn County ~ Probation cases are "No Contact" per judge. Status hearings, even if victim wants no contact judge demands hearing. Victims can fill out a form to request contact or victim is required to speak in court. Caseload – approx. 70 offenders; 0 misdo; 3-4 prison releases monthly. No victim advocate in P&P Office.

Klamath County ~ CPC Audits soon- DV, SO TX, MRT. ODARA training 8/25/15

Lake County ~ New ACS supervisor, new Drug Court two months ago. There are 2 PPO's with approx. 58 offenders on caseload and they do supervise misdo's.

Multnomah County ~ Testing ODARA on female offenders. Tiffany has article FAPA Gun Disposition process. Pretrial Release Best Practices info card.

Marion County ~ Hiring 4-5 PPO's, Marion co. is having a problem with offenders using bath salts. LSCMI 12 and less are in Casebank. Pre-TX everyone before DVIC.

Jefferson County ~ SO & DV caseload, this includes misdo's. Director is currently interim over Juvenile too.

Lane County ~ Hired 2 PPO's, hiring 4 more PPO's. General caseloads LSCMI 19 and under are going to Casebank. DV LSCMI 12 and less to reduced supervision. Not sending directly to DVIC. Assess stage of change first then MRT/RNR or they are referred back to PO for BIP tx.

Columbia County ~ Judge wants to start survivor panel, ODARA 8/21/15

Union County ~ 2 PPO's at FTO's for 2 new PPO's. Probation services specialist – emp connections, MRT, Cog. . Approx. 111 offenders per caseload.

Hood River County ~ Approx. 75 offenders per caseload (DV, MIO, General). 3 PPO's and Commander, new intern. Alcohol use violations? GC 4- tx rules. New relationships – PPO talk to, BIP input. Norcor is matrixing no DV.
