### **Introductions/County updates-**

-Multnomah: Creating Medium level supervision caseloads to deal with budget cuts (100 offenders per 1 PO).....Working on a universal approved treatment provider list, to accommodate clients who transfer counties, and to better deal with complaints.

-Clackamas: Hiring a new P.O....Under the direction of the Sheriff's Office, but they are their own separate entity.

### **Nomination & Election of Training Chair-**

-Election of the new Training Coordinator to replace Brent Taylor.  
Selection of two co-chairs. Trin Monohan, Columbia Co, & Seth Prouser, Marion Co.

### **Creation of Automation Committee-**

-Lisa Sims will be point of contact for suggestions for automations; recruitment of volunteers for new module testing.

Polygraph module is still being developed and discussed.

### **Oregon State Police-**

-NOD (Notice of Discharge) forms(181.586, 181.588): Biggest issue for OSP is when a past Predatory SO comes back on supervision for a non sex offense, but is not supervised by an SO PO, no NOD form is being completed upon the client's expiration from supervision. This is a problem that needs fixing.....SOSN supports and "edit" which will flag file, reminding non SO PO's to complete a NOD form prior to file closure.

**\*\*\*\*\*NOD FORMS ONLY NEED TO BE COMPLETED ON PREDATORY SEX OFFENDERS.....NOT ON ALL REGISTERED SEX OFFENDERS\*\*\*\*\***

-OSP is limited as to what information they can release upon public inquires about clients on supervision for their first sex offense. People inquiring are often referred back to local law enforcement.

-SO's must report to LE to provide information on registration forms, and actually PROVIDE the information needed to complete the form, as well as provide a signature....Failure to do so is Failing to Register.

-OSP is working on "Legislative concepts" victim ID, relief from registration, juvenile relief, \$70 annual SO registration fees, allowing a representative (durable power of attorney) to register for an SO who can't do it themselves due to physical or mental incapacitation

### **IRT's-**

Roundtable discussion about IRT process. Nothing new decided at this time. Important to stick to the OAR's.

### **Subcommittee's report-**

Best Practices: Nothing to report....IRT's still under discussion as far as how to get all counties to comply with OAR's.

Website: SOSN website

Training: Would like to get the Predatory evaluators to come to next SOSN meeting, to explain how the process works.....Interest in having Kurt St. Dennis present on interview techniques (not MI) to elicit info. From offenders....Possibly have Jeff Snider present on how to do detailed computer searches.

Legislative: Working on clarifying verbiage on what does “supervising agency” mean in ORS.....Waiting to see how the November vote goes on two purposed tax increases: Corporate and personal income (couples making over \$250,000).

Automation: Working on developing a polygraph module...Changes to Stable/Acute to better track completions (low priority).

**PSO/SVDO-**

Now able to track these designation in CIS/DOC400/ISIS F11, 4, Y(W/W/ Offender Designators) \*\*See Attachment \*\*

SOSN agrees that all SO PO's should enter Community Notification information (dates, types of notification) for their current Predatory SO's and all future PSO's on their caseloads into CS/DOC400/ISIS using the new community notification tracking system. This will be taken to OACCD as a recommendation.
