Coffee Creek Correctional Facility

Coffee Creek Correctional Facility (CCCF) is a multi-custody prison accommodating all of Oregon's female inmates from intake to release. It is also home to the state's intake center, providing evaluation of all male inmates committed to state custody by the courts. CCCF opened its minimum-security facility in October 2001 and its medium-security facility in April 2002.
