Rob Poirier moved to approve the minutes as written. Joe Seibert seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

2. Matthew Lytle DPSST#43767 - Final Order

Linsay Hale reviewed the case for the committee.

Rob Poirier moved to approve issuing the Final Order that has been prepared by the Department in consultation with the Department of Justice to Matthew Lytle. Jeff Martin seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Rob Poirier moved to verify for the record that DPSST will not, beyond the denial period in Agency Case #43767, deny certification and training to Mr. Lytle based upon the current agency record, including the meal card and DUII incidents. DPSST may consider new evidence and conduct and may consider such evidence and conduct in light of the current agency record. Jeff Martin seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

After further discussion, Lindsay clarified that the meal card and DUII incidents alone cannot be used in future cases for revocation/denial, but may be taken into consideration in addition to new issues.
