Chief Wrenn died on February 25th, 1882 at a grain mill fire when a wall of the structure collapsed and fell on him. In his honor, the Corvallis Fire Department and the Ladies Auxiliary purchased a Memorial Bell in 1912, that was mounted in front of the main fire station at SW 4th and Madison Ave. That bell today is still displayed at our main fire station at 4th and Harrison in front of the station under the gazebo.
