Moreover, Exhibit K demonstrates that the Project complies with the statewide planning goals adopted by the Land Conservation and Development Commission (LCDC). To demonstrate the same, IPC elects under Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 345-022-0030(2)(b) to have the Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC or Council) determine that: (i) the Project complies with applicable substantive criteria, LCDC administrative rules, and directly applicable land use statutes; or (ii) the Project does not comply with one or more applicable substantive criteria but the Project otherwise complies with the statewide planning goals or an exception is justified.

The Applicant submitted its final Application for Site Certification on October 3, 2018. Subsequently, the Oregon Department of Energy requested certain additional information about the Project pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 345-015-0190(9). This errata sheet provides the requested information—which may include corrections to the exhibit text, tables, figures, and/or proposed conditions—as it relates to Exhibit K.
