Re: Preliminary Application for Site Certificate for the Bakeoven Solar Project

Dear Mr. Cornett:

On behalf of Avangrid Renewables, LLC, Bakeoven Solar, LLC (Applicant) submits this Preliminary Application for Site Certificate (pASC) for the Bakeoven Solar Project (Facility). The Applicant proposes to construct and operate a photovoltaic (PV) solar energy generation facility and related or supporting facilities located in Wasco County, Oregon. The Facility will consist of up to 303 megawatts (MW) and include a battery storage system capable of storing up to 100 MW of energy; designed to stabilize the solar resource and provide flexibility in responding to market and customer demands. The Facility will interconnect to the existing 230-kilovolt (kV) Bonneville Power Administration Big Eddy to Redmond transmission line at the existing Maupin Interconnection Substation. The interconnection will occur via a proposed new 230-kV transmission line, approximately 11 miles in length, to be constructed by the Applicant.

The Applicant anticipates filing a supplement to the pASC within 30 days. The supplement will contain the following attachments to Exhibit P:
