Meetings of the Committee are open to the public. Parties interested in the regulation and practice of landscape architecture are invited to attend virtually by phone or videoconference. During the meeting, the Committee will review the OSLAB administrative rules for registration and continuing education. The Committee will discuss current rule requirements and various implementation issues with the status quo rules. The Committee may develop recommendations to OSLAB about possible rule amendments. The Committee may also discuss other possible rule projects for the 2023-2025 biennium and general Committee business.

The Committee Chair will accept public comment as noted on the meeting agenda. Public comment is limited to matters on the public meeting agenda or otherwise relevant to matters that may come before the Committee. The Committee Chair may set a time allotment for public comment and may stop public comment that is irrelevant or disruptive to the Committee's conduct of its business.
