ORS 675.715(2) requires applicant to hold graduate degree in counseling from a CACREP approved program, a degree determined to meet comparable standards adopted by the Board, or a degree program determined to meet a majority of the standards adopted by the Board as long as the applicant can document completion of all the coursework required by the standards. OAR 833-025-0001(2)(b)(K) requires the degree program to require minimum coursework as set forth in OAR 833-025-0005 which includes graduate coursework in at least six of eight areas. Applicant's degree program required coursework in only five of the eight areas. Coursework was not required in the areas of group dynamics, lifestyles and career counseling, and professional orientation. Applicant's degree program did not require a clinical placement in counseling, but accepted two experiences doing school psychology.


3. ORS 675.715(3) as defined by OAR 833-020-0050 requires applicant to document three years of full-time supervised work experience in the form and manner required by the Board, no less than 2,400 client contact hours of counseling meeting standards for supervision which must either have been within the degree program or after the degree was awarded. Applicant did not have her supervisors file attestation of supervised work experience on Board provided forms. Copies of the clinical experience affidavits filed in the State of Wisconsin were submitted. Forms do not show supervisor's training, experience, and credentials nor show direct client contact hours and supervision hours.

4. OAR 833-020-0020 required applicants who fail to become licensed within one year to reapply. One year from application was June 16, 1999.

5. The Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists' application file and the documents therein are incorporated by reference in support of this order in the form the file existed on August 20, 1999.


