



Pamela Antognini does not hold a graduate degree in counseling from a program approved by CACREP, or a graduate degree, under standards explicitly adopted in OAR 833-25-001 through OAR 833-25-005, that is determined to be comparable or meets a majority of the as required for licensure by ORS 675.715(2). There was no mandatory clinical experience, nor did Ms. Antognini voluntarily take a clinical/applied experience course within her degree program, nor has she completed all the coursework required for persons who hold degrees that meet only a majority of standards, lacking at least a three quarter hours course in lifestyles and career development.

#### OPINION

Pamela Antognini completed a degree program track that did not meet the California licensing standard. The school catalogs clearly stated that licensure required a field experience and listed those particular courses, which indicates that school did not consider the track she completed to prepare a graduate for licensure. Ms. Antognini has taken post-degree graduate training, but the Board has determined that the law directs it to review only the degree program either for full standards or for a majority of those standards.

#### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Pamela Antognini's application for licensure as a professional counselor be refused and the file closed.
