



**Facts and Statements in Support of Order**

1. Application for licensure signed by Charles H Benson was received on approximately 6/21/93. Applicant failed to complete the application process within one year as set forth in OAR 833-020-002 by not documenting to the satisfaction of the Board that he met the standards for licensure:

A. Although Board found applicant's degree program to meet a majority of standards as allowed under ORS 675.715 and OAR 833-020-0040(4), applicant submitted no documentation such as course number, description, or syllabi to prove that he had completed a graduate program in the area of Lifestyle and Career Development as required by OAR 833-025-0005.

B. Applicant documented 2,009 client contact hours of supervised work experience meeting standards; however, the remaining experience under supervisor Frey did not indicate supervision in compliance with the licensing standards set forth in OAR 833-020-0050 because the supervisor provided only group supervision instead of at least 50 percent individual supervision. Licensure requires documentation of no less than 2,400 client contact hours of supervised work experience meeting the standards for supervision.

2. OAR 833-020-0020 requires applicants who fail to become licensed within one year to reapply. One year from application was 6/21/94; however, applicant petitioned and received a year extension, until 6/21/95.

3. The Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists application file and the documents therein are incorporated by reference in support of this order in the form the file existed on 8/25/95.

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
