







1 4.2 Ms. Bernards shall undergo supervision for no less than  
2 12 months by a licensed professional counselor or licensed  
3 marriage and family therapist, or another licensed mental health  
4 professional, approved by the Board.

5 A. The supervisor will be chosen by the Board from a list  
6 of three submitted by Ms. Bernards. The professionals  
7 submitted by Ms. Bernards shall have no dual relation-  
ship with Ms. Bernards and be willing to provide  
supervision.

8 B. Submission of the list, which will include background  
9 information about the credentials, training, supervision  
10 expertise, and supervisor's willingness to provide  
supervision and report to the Board, shall be made  
within 20 days from entry of this order.

11 C. Following written Board approval of the supervisor,  
12 Ms. Bernards shall enter into a written agreement with  
the supervisor. The agreement shall include but not be  
13 limited to the following provisions: (1) supervision  
shall specifically address, but is not limited to,  
14 client-related ethics issues; (2) supervision shall be  
occur no less than two hours per month during the 12  
15 months following approval of the supervisor and  
notification of commencement of supervision; (3) the  
16 supervisor's responsibilities regarding the schedule,  
content, and form for reporting to the Board; and (4)  
the date of the first supervision meeting.

17 D. Ms. Bernards shall file a photocopy of the signed  
18 agreement with the Board no later than 15 days following  
notification of Board selection/approval of the  
19 supervisor.

20 E. Any dispute between Ms. Bernards and the Board-approved  
21 supervisor will be resolved by the Board at its regularly  
scheduled meeting in an informal binding hearing, with  
22 testimony limited to the supervisor and Ms. Bernards or  
through a delegated representative of the Board who will  
23 hear from both parties. Any problems or unanticipated  
situations that impede completion of the supervision  
24 will be brought to the Board's attention through  
immediate written communication with the Board.

25 F. All costs of supervision will be borne entirely by  
26 Ms. Bernards.

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1 G. The supervisor shall provide quarterly formal reports to  
2 the Board at six-month intervals during the 12-month  
3 period. Each report shall be in writing and detail  
4 Ms. Bernard's progress, whether she has been participating  
5 in good faith, and whether Ms. Bernard is aware of the  
6 ethical concerns the Board has indicated. The final report  
7 shall provide an objective evaluation of Ms. Bernard's  
8 ability to continue practice without supervision.

9 H. Ms. Bernard consents to the supervisor contacting the  
10 Board if the supervisor believes there is a risk to the  
11 public by the continued practice of Ms. Bernard as a  
12 professional counselor.

13 4.3 Ms. Bernard shall not supervise licensed professional  
14 counselors, licensed marriage and family therapists, or any person  
15 seeking licensure with the Board during the mandated supervision.

16 4.4 Ms. Bernard shall not provide child custody evaluation  
17 services during the period of probation.

18 4.5 Ms. Bernard agrees the probation will not be concluded  
19 until all terms have been fulfilled and documented to the  
20 satisfaction of the Board.

21 4.6 The Board agrees not to send a press release announcing  
22 disciplinary action to Ms. Bernard's local papers; but notes the  
23 information is a public record that may be provided to the  
24 inquiring public, and will be included in all reports of Board  
25 disciplinary actions under standard operating procedures.

26 5.

If the Board finds, after a contested case hearing, that  
Ms. Bernard has materially violated any of the terms of this  
Stipulation Final Order, the violation(s) shall constitute grounds  
for revocation of license.
