



2. Application materials included verification from the State of New Mexico Counseling and Therapy Practice Board, that Applicant held licensure as a professional clinical mental health counselor. The documentation shows Applicant was "grandfathered" and no examination was required.
3. ORS 675.735 as defined by OAR 833-020-0140 requires Applicant to document that she held a counseling license issued by another state under standards equivalent to Oregon's education, experience and examination requirements. Applicant did not document that New Mexico licensure required applicants to pass an examination in order to be licensed.
4. ORS 675.715 requires application to be made in form and manner required by Board. OAR 833-020-0001 requires all applications to be accompanied by an official transcript. Applicant did not submit an official transcript.
5. OAR 833-020-0020 required applicants who fail to complete the application process to become licensed within two years to reapply. Two years from date of application was July 29, 1999.
6. The Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists' application file and the documents therein are incorporated by reference in support of this order in the form the file existed on August 20, 1998.
