License of) RESIGNATION OF LICENSE

Jacquelyn M. Bruni

On or about November 16, 1999, the Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists (Board) began investigation into allegations regarding the conduct of Jacquelyn M. Bruni (Licensee). The allegations involved possible violation of client boundaries and client confidentiality.

After being contacted by the Board, the Licensee expressed her desire to resign her license.

The Board and Licensee agree that the investigation may be concluded by the entry of this Stipulation on the following terms. The Board and Licensee agree:

1. The Board has jurisdiction over the license, including the right to suspend or revoke a license if the Board were to prove that the licensee violated either the licensure statute or one or more of the rules of the Board, specifically relating to entering into dual relationships with clients and breaching client confidentiality.

2. The Board accepts the resignation of Licensee's marriage and family therapist license (T0017).

3. Following resignation, the license may not be reinstated or renewed.

4. Licensee waives her right to a contested case hearing and waives the right to be represented by an attorney at such a hearing.

5. Licensee waives her right to judicial review or appeal of this order.


6. Licensee waives any and all civil claims or actions against the Board and its employees relating to this issue.

7. By signature below, Licensee swears that this resignation was not made under duress and that she has read and fully understands the terms of this agreement.




