

2. Licensee agrees to a civil penalty of \$250.00, which is stayed.
3. Licensee agrees to a 30-day suspension of his license, considered to have been served in the 30 days prior to the expiration of his license on April 1, 2003.
4. Should licensee reapply for licensure at any time, the Board requires he agree to and meet the following conditions:
 - a. The \$250 civil penalty shall become immediately due and payable;
 - b. Licensee will be supervised for a period of one year by a licensed mental health professional approved by the Board. Supervision, if he practices 45 hours of client contact per month or less, shall be for two hours per month, with each hour taking place in separate weeks of that month;
 - c. If practicing 46 hours per month or more, his supervision requirement shall be for three hours per month, each hour taking place in separate weeks of that month;
 - d. The supervisor shall make quarterly written reports to the Board. Licensee is responsible to see the Board receives the reports;
 - e. The supervisor may require licensee to complete coursework in any areas the supervisor identified as necessary for the licensee to be able to practice safely, e.g. treatment of developmentally disabled persons, ethics, etc.
 - f. The period of supervision could be extended in three-month increments, dependent upon the supervisor's recommendation and/or at the Board's discretion. This is beyond the one year period of supervision.
5. Licensee acknowledges the violations alleged in the Board's July 12, 2001 Notice of Proposed License Revocation.
6. The document memorializing the agreement shall be public record.
7. The matter will be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank-Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (NPDB-HIPDB).

IN SIGNING THIS STIPULATED AGREEMENT, LICENSEE ACKNOWLEDGES:

I understand that in the event I engage in future conduct resulting in violations of law, or terms of licensure, the Board may take further disciplinary action against my license, up to and including revocation of my license.

I understand that the Board considers the conduct resulting in the alleged violations of law described in this stipulation to be of a grave nature and if continued, constitutes a serious danger to public health and safety.

I understand that by entering into the stipulated agreement, I waive the right to an administrative hearing.

I have read this stipulation and understand it completely.







I.

The Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, disciplining and regulating the practice of Licensed Professional Counselors and Family Therapists. The Board has jurisdiction over the license of Peter J. DiPaoli, (licensee).

II.

The Board issued a Notice of Proposed License Revocation on July 12, 2001. The Notice alleged Licensee had violated:

1. ORS 675.745(1)(c) and ORS 675.745(1)(d) for gross negligence in the practice of counseling.
2. OAR 833-060-0001(2)(c) by permitting undue influence by a third person into the evaluation and treatment of a client.
3. OAR 833-060-0001(1) and (1)(a) by failing to advance the welfare of a client by seeking additional expertise or referral.
4. OAR 833-060-0001(i) for failing to terminate a client relationship after several years when it was clear treatment was no longer serves the clients needs.
5. OAR 833-060-0001(4)(g) for providing substandard counseling resulting in the inadequate treatment of a client.

III.

Licensee has denied the allegations of misconduct and timely requested a hearing. Recognizing that the Board has legitimate concerns, Licensee wishes to cooperate with the Board in resolving the present disciplinary matter.

THEREFORE, the following will be proposed to the Board and is agreed to by Licensee:

1. Licensee has allowed his professional licensed lapse. He has not renewed his license.

2. Licensee agrees to a civil penalty of \$250.00, which is stayed.
3. Licensee agrees to a 30-day suspension of his license, considered to have been served in the 30 days prior to the expiration of his license on April 1, 2003.
4. Should licensee reapply for licensure at any time, the Board requires he agree to and meet the following conditions:






