Effective Date

Unless a hearing is requested in writing addressed to the Administrator, Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists, 796 Winter Street, NE, Salem, OR 97310, and is received on or before close of business within 60 days or September 1, 1993, or a stipulated agreement is effected on or prior to that date, this order becomes a final order without further action.

Proposed and Final Order

Renewal of the professional counselor license (C0219) of ROBERT C GROTZ is refused based upon the facts set forth herein and incorporated by reference and the license shall be deemed to have expired.

Right to a Hearing

The licensee, ROBERT C GROTZ, has the right to request a hearing under the provisions of ORS chapter 183. If a hearing is requested, information on the procedures, right of representation and the rights of parties will be given before the commencement of the hearing.

Waiver

If no hearing is requested, ROBERT C GROTZ waives any statutory requirements as to the form of the order including Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law under the provisions of ORS 183.470.

Facts and Statements of Violations in Support of Order


1. Licensee's license expired under the provisions of subsection ORS 675.275(3) because the licensee did not make application pursuant to ORS 675.725 (1) and (2)(b), and OAR 833-25-050 and 060 as set forth in OAR 833-30-010. Refusal to renew is made pursuant to ORS 675.745(1)(d). Complete application as described must be made on or before May 1.
2. Application for renewal, without completed continuing education report, signed by licensee was received by Board representatives February 19, 1993. Supplemental completed form post-marked May 10, 1993 was received May 11, 1993 showing 14 hours taken between April 1, 1992 and April 1, 1993.
3. On or about March 8, 1993, a letter was sent to the licensee indicating the license could not be renewed without filing continuing education requirements as required by the Board. A second reminder was mailed April 23, 1994.
4. ORS 675.745(1)(d) states the Board may refuse to issue or renew any license upon proof that the licensee has violated rules. OAR 833-25-050 requires licensees to complete 20 clock hours of approved continuing education every license year, April 1, through April 1, as a condition of renewal.

5. DAR 833-25-050(2) allows a maximum of 10 hours or no more than half of the continuing education hours to be satisfied through receipt of professional supervision by a licensed mental health professional.

6. DAR 833-25-050(3) allows no more than half of the education hours claimed to be satisfied through distance learning, which under DAR 833-25-050(E) must include a mechanism for evaluation or measurement of learning.

7. The Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists license file and the documents therein are incorporated by reference in support of this order in the form of the application for renewal as it existed on May 14, 1993.


