On or about November 3, 1993, a notice stating that the Board intended to suspend marriage and family therapist license number T0239 was served upon Carolyn M. Mann by certified mail. This notice alleged that Carolyn M. Mann (licensee) violated the rules of the Board by not meeting the annual continuing education requirements during license year 1993-94.

Pursuant to a written request for hearing as provided by ORS Chapter 183, a hearing before the Board was scheduled for February 18, 1994 at 1:45 pm in the Conference Room of the State Archives Building, Salem, Oregon. Notice of date, time, and place of the hearing and information on procedures, right to representation, and the rights of parties relating to the conduct of the hearing was served upon Carolyn M. Mann on or about January 14, 1994 by certified mail. The licensee was present but not represented by an attorney.

Now therefore, after consideration of the records and files of the board relating to this matter, a majority of the Board enters the following order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Licensee did not receive the Board's request for proof of continuing education.
2. Licensee completed 20 clock hours of continuing education as documented by a copy of an NASW certificat of continuing education September 12, 1992.

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Licensee had proof of meeting the continuing education requirements for licensure for 1993-94.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The number of hours of continuing education required for renewal by ORS 675.725(1)(d) were fulfilled to the satisfaction of the Board.

OPINION


Because the Board could not prove that licensee received its request for continuing education materials, the Board must accept the testimony of the licensee that she knew nothing about it. In addition, licensee had the necessary documentation to respond to the audit.

ORDER

Providing sufficient evidence that the minimum standards and requirements for annual continuing education were met, the marriage and family therapist license of Carolyn M. Mann will not be suspended.
