STIPULATED FINAL ORDER

Pursuant to ORS 675.785 and 675.745, the above-entitled matter came before the Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists (Board) upon complaint of Judith B. Settles alleging that Karren A. Mooney (Licensee) violated the counselor-client confidentiality provisions of ORS 675.765 and OAR 833-60-001; Licensee having filed an answer denying the allegations in the notice of suspension served by the Board and requesting a hearing; and the Board acting through Carol F. Fleming, Administrator, and Thomas E. Elliott, counsel for Licensee, having negotiated an informal resolution as follows:

1. Licensee:

(A) Denies any unethical behavior, wrongdoing, or violation of statute or rule occurred in this case.

(B) Acknowledges that she was advised of her right to a hearing and representation by counsel at a hearing and waives her right to such hearing and representation.

(C) Accepts Board jurisdiction the matter.

(D) Waives any civil claims or actions against the Board with regards to this case.

(E) Agrees to maintain clinical supervision with another licensed mental health professional (LCSW, LPC, LMFT, or psychologist) at least once per month for six months following this agreement. Upon completion, Licensee shall provide written verification to the Board from the supervisor.

(F) Agrees to complete either a graduate course; six-hour workshop, seminar, or course; or equivalent on the subject of ethical issues facing mental health professionals. Approval of the course, workshop, seminar, or its equivalent, shall be obtained from the Board in advance and is to be completed within one-year one-year of the date of this final order.

(G) Agrees to pay a \$100 settlement fee at the time of settlement.

2. The Board:


(A) Agrees that no unethical behavior, wrongdoing, or violation of statute or rule of the Board in this case has been proven.

(B) Withdraws the Notice of Proposed Suspension dated June 21, 1994.

(C) Agrees that no disciplinary action shall be taken in this case.

3. If it is determined, after a contested case hearing, that Licensee has failed to materially perform or materially violated any of the terms or conditions of this stipulation, that violation shall constitute grounds for suspension of the Licensee's professional counselor license.
