

2002. The referral came through the emergency room for suicidal ideation, psychotic symptoms, and grief issues related to her four year old son being taken from her by her ex-husband.

4. During March 2002, RM went to the Gresham police with concerns about the counseling she received from Licensee. The Gresham police investigated the matter and provided recording equipment for three telephone calls made to Licensee by RM in reference to her concerns. In March 2002, RM recorded three phone calls made to Licensee.
5. During telephone calls made from RM to Licensee, Licensee did not appropriately respond, did not provide appropriate counseling of the issues raised during the calls, but focused on in-person therapy. In an interview before the Board, Licensee stated due to demands of a large caseload, he lacked the time management skills and that may have led him to not focus on this patient during those telephone calls. This failure constitutes a violation of OAR 833-060-001(1)(g).
6. Licensee violated ORS 675.745(1)(c), and was negligent in his role as RM's counselor in that he did not make a reasonable effort to advance the welfare and best interest of the client during those conversations. This also violates OAR 833-060-0001(1).

IN SIGNING THIS STIPULATED FINAL ORDER, LICENSEE ACKNOWLEDGES:

I understand that in the event I engage in future conduct resulting in violations of law, or terms of licensure, the Board may take further disciplinary action against my license, up to and including revocation of my license.

I understand that by entering into this Stipulated Final Order, I waive the right to an administrative hearing.

No promises, representation, duress, or coercion have been used to induce me to sign this stipulation.

I have read this stipulation and understand it completely.

I understand that this stipulation will be submitted to the Board for approval and is subject to the Board's confirmation.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Licensee is reprimanded.
2. Licensee will obtain three graduate level university credits in counseling ethics or will get 40 hours of CE's in ethics, approved by the NASW, NBCC, OPA or ACA. Licensee will provide proof of attendance and completion to the Board. This requirement shall be completed within two years of the effective date of this Stipulated Final Order.
3. Licensee will be on a plan of supervision for 2 years from the effective date of this Stipulated Final Order with a Board-approved supervisor. If Licensee is employed by Kaiser Permanente or in a clinical setting during the pendency of this Stipulated Final Order, Licensee will meet with Supervisor every 6 months and the supervisor will report to OBLPCT every six months. If Licensee is in private practice during the pendency of this Stipulated Final Order, Licensee will meet with the supervisor monthly and the supervisor will report to OBLPCT every six months.
4. Licensee will receive personal therapy monthly with a personal therapist for 1 year focusing on professional stress management, transference, and work-life management issues. Licensee's therapist shall send reports to the Board every six months.
5. For a two year period, Licensee will not be a supervisor of any other counselors or employees during the pendency of this Stipulated Final Order. Licensee agrees to limit his therapy practice to an adults and families as a group during the pendency of this Stipulated Final Order.

6. Licensee is on probation for 1 year from the effective date of this Stipulated Final Order.
7. Licensee shall be fined \$250, payable within 12 months of the effective date of this Stipulated Final Order.
