The Board and Licensee agree that this matter may be concluded by the entry of this Stipulation on the following terms:

Term #1: Licensee agrees that within six months of the effective date of this order he will identify and within one year of the effective date of this order will be enrolled in a course in child diagnostics approved by the Board. Licensee agrees to document successful completion of the class within six months from enrollment. Licensee also agrees within one year of the effective date of this order to complete 20 clock hours of training in interviewing, risk management, and/or related topics (with prior approval of the Board):

- (A) The child diagnostics training program must be a graduate course or the equivalent training geared to persons with graduate training.
- (B) Approval of the training will be obtained by written request to the Board office, which will include a printed description of the training, sponsoring entity, and presenters. The request should allow sufficient time for review and approval/disapproval by a representative of the Board. The Board will apply the standardized continuing education program requirements when evaluating the proposed program.
- (C) The clock hours of training may be reported as continuing education to apply toward the hours need to meet the continuing education requirement for renewal of license.

Term #2: Licensee agrees to obtain clinical supervision, from a Board approved supervisor, for all cases involving children until such time as he has completed and documented to the Board completion of the required training in child diagnostics. Licensee agrees to have a Board approved supervisor in place within 45 days from the effective date of this order.

- (A) Supervision will be at least one hour per month.
- (B) Supervisor will be selected by the Board from a list and cover letters plus resumes of no less than three licensed mental health professionals submitted by Licensee to Board. The professionals for consideration must express, in a cover letter, a willingness to provide this supervision.
- (C) Supervision will consist of, but not be limited to, review of licensees ongoing cases (treatment and progress notes) involving children, consultation regarding approach, relationship with clients, general department, and interaction with colleagues in allied professions.
- (D) Supervision will be under written agreement between Licensee and supervisor (copy filed with Board). Terms of agreement will include a waiver to allow supervisor to confer with Board and to provide the Board with an evaluation report submitted at the end of the supervision period. The report shall include comment on Licensee's participation, progress, awareness of Board concerns, and evaluation of competence).

- (E) Any disputes between supervisor and Licensee will be settled by the Board at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- (F) The supervision report shall be confidential except if needed in a subsequent contested case hearing.

Term # 3: Licensee agrees to refrain from providing clinical supervision to other mental health professionals while under probation.

Term #4: Licensee agrees to pay to the Board, and submits with this order or within 10 days of this order, the amount of \$500 to help offset the costs of preparation and supervision of this agreement. Licensee further agrees to bear the costs involved with compliance with the terms of the agreement: tuition and training fees, and costs of supervision.

Term #5: The Board agrees that its proposed order of suspension is withdrawn, but formally reprimands Jim S. Stumbo and places his license on probation until such time as he has documented to the satisfaction of the Board that he has complied with all terms of this agreement, but in any case, no less than six months from the effective date of this order.

If the Board finds, after a contested case hearing, that Licensee has materially violated any of the terms of this stipulation, the violation shall constitute grounds for revocation of license, which will prevent re-licensure for five years.

If Licensee requests permission to resign license or allows license to expire before completing the terms of this agreement, the status will reflect forfeiture of license while under disciplinary action.
