<b>RICHARD B. KING, LPC</b>	)	<b>FINAL STIPULATED ORDER</b>

The Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists (“Board”) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating, and disciplining Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists in the State of Oregon.

1.

Pursuant to ORS 675.745 (1)(c) and 675.745 (1)(d), on July 14, 2008, the Board issued a Notice of Proposed Discipline, Case No. 2005-008, alleging facts if proven would support the Board’s proposed sanction to revoke the professional counseling license of Richard B. King (“Licensee”). The Board incorporates by reference the Proposed Notice of Discipline issued on July 14, 2008. In 2008 the Board received a complaint about Licensee and opened an investigation as Case No. 2008-006.

2.

By entering into this Final Stipulated Order Licensee does not admit or make any admission of the facts alleged in Notice of Proposed Discipline for Case No. 2005-008, or any admission relating to the investigation of Case No. 2008-006.

3.

The conduct alleged in the Proposed Notice of Discipline, if proven, would constitute violations of ORS 675.745(1)(d), OAR 833-060-0001(1) and (2).

4.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle the above-referenced matters by entry of this Final Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes, in the matter of Case No. 2005-008, and would have a right to a contested case hearing in the matter of Case No. 2008-006 if this matter proceeded to discipline. Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom in these matters by the signing of and entry of this Final Stipulated Order.

5.

Licensee and the Board agree to resolve the matters of Case No. 2005-008, and Case No. 2008-006 by the entry of this Final Stipulated Order, subject to the following terms and

conditions:

- 5.1 Licensee permanently surrenders his Oregon license as a Licensed Professional Counselor effective December 8, 2008, and will no longer be a licensed professional counselor in this state.
- 5.2 Licensee agrees not to apply, seek reinstatement, register or apply to practice with this Board at any time in the future.
- 5.3 Licensee is prohibited from using the title of, purporting to be, or practicing as a Licensed Professional Counselor or Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist in this state.
- 5.4 Licensee agrees to pay the Board the sum of \$1,000 for reimbursement of costs expended in these matters pursuant to ORS 675.745(6). Licensee shall pay the sum of \$1,000 in ten equal monthly installments of \$100 per month, without interest. The first monthly installment shall be due within 30 days of this Final Stipulated Order.
- 5.5 This stipulation resolves all matters between the Licensee and this Board.
- 5.6 Failure to comply with the terms of this stipulation herein may result in discipline by the Board.
