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1 The Oregon Board of Naturopathic Examiners has determined there is evidence that
2 Licensee engaged in conduct that might constitute a danger to the health or safety of a patient
3 and Licensee aided or abetted the unlawful practice of a healing art when Robert Sainz
4 performed chiropractic adjustments on A.A. on August 6, 2004, and B.P. on October 14, 2004 at
5 Licensee's office.

6 5.

7 The Board issues this letter or Reprimand and imposed Civil Penalties in the
8 amount of \$1,000. Payment for Civil Penalties received April 7, 2006.

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10 This is the only action by the Board at this time, however, the fact that Licensee engaged
11 in conduct that might constitute a danger to the health or safety of a patient and aided in the
12 unlawful practice of a healing art may be considered as an aggravating factors in any future
13 violation.
