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1.

The Board of Naturopathic Medicine (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining naturopathic physicians in the State of Oregon. At all relevant times, Jeffrey A. Kiker, N.D., (Licensee) has been a licensed naturopathic physician subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.

2.

The Board issued to Licensee a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action and Opportunity for Hearing (Notice) on December 16, 2010. The Board proposed to revoke Licensee's license to practice naturopathic medicine. Licensee timely requested a hearing.

3.

The Board finds and Licensee admits to the following:

a. In March 2010, Licensee was traveling from Oregon to Colorado by automobile with approximately ten pounds of marijuana that he intended to sell to a dispensary in Colorado. On March 6, 2010, while traveling through Idaho, Licensee was arrested and charged with felony Trafficking in Marijuana and felony Criminal Conspiracy. Licensee was subsequently convicted of Possession of a Controlled Substance with the Intent to Deliver, a felony in Idaho. Licensee did not report his Idaho arrest to the Board within 30 days.

b. Licensee's conduct constitutes violations of: ORS 685.110(6), ORS 685.110(14), ORS 670.280, OAR 850-050-0120(6)(b), and OAR 850-050-0190(3).

4.

The parties desire to settle this matter by entering into this Stipulation for Voluntary Surrender of License in Lieu of Revocation, pursuant to ORS 183.417(3).

5.

Licensee stipulates, understands, and agrees to the following:

a. Licensee voluntarily surrenders his license as a naturopathic physician, and requests that the Board accept his surrender. This voluntary surrender in lieu of revocation is subject to and conditioned upon acceptance by the Board. If accepted by the Board, this voluntary surrender shall be effective September 30, 2011.

b. In the event that Licensee applies for licensure with the Board in the future, the Board may as part of any review, consideration, or decision on the application, consider his conduct in this matter in addition to any other information obtained as part of the application process. This Stipulation does not in any way restrict or limit the Board as part of its review, consideration, and decision on any application submitted by Licensee.

c. Following the effective date of surrender, Licensee shall be prohibited in the State of Oregon from using the title of, or purporting to be, a naturopathic physician, N.D., naturopath, or Doctor of Naturopathy, or using any other title that includes those words.

d. Following the effective date of surrender, Licensee shall not engage in the practice of "naturopathic medicine", as defined in ORS 685.010, in the State of Oregon without being appropriately licensed with the Board.

e. Licensee understands that this Stipulation is a public record and is reportable to the National Practitioners Data Bank.

f. Any violation of this Stipulation is grounds for further action against Licensee. The Board has the right to take action against Licensee to enforce this Stipulation, or for other violations of ORS Chapter 685 or OAR Chapter 850 that are not referenced in the Notice.

6.

Licensee has fully read and understands this Stipulation. Licensee has had the opportunity to consult with an attorney and has been fully advised in regards thereto or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering this Stipulation.

7.

Licensee enters into this Stipulation and consents to issuance of the order below voluntarily and without any force or duress. Licensee acknowledges that no promises or representation not stated herein have been made to induce Licensee to sign this Stipulation.

8.

Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (ORS Chapter 183), and fully and finally waives any and all right to a hearing and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation.

It is so STIPULATED.

CONSENT ORDER

It is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Stipulation for Voluntary Surrender of License in Lieu of Revocation submitted by Jeffrey A. Kiker, ND is accepted by the Board and shall be effective September 30, 2011;


2. Jeffrey A. Kiker shall, within fourteen (14) calendar days of the effective date of surrender, return his original license certificate to the Board;

3. After September 30, 2011, in the State of Oregon, Jeffrey A. Kiker shall not use the title of, or purport to be, a naturopathic physician, N.D., naturopath, or Doctor of Naturopathy, or use any other title that includes those words; and

4. After September 30, 2011, Jeffrey A. Kiker shall not engage in the practice of "naturopathic medicine", as defined in ORS 685.010, in the State of Oregon without being appropriately licensed with the Board.
