

**Oregon Board of Naturopathic Examiners - Formulary Council Meeting Minutes
March 17, 2008**

PRESENT: Kevin Wilson, ND (Chair); Dohn Kruschwitz, MD; Ann Blair, PhD; Mike Mockler, RPh; Cathy Rakers, RPh; Rick Marinelli, ND, Anne Walsh and guests.

EXCUSED: John Block, PhD

The meeting opened at 9:35am.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes were approved from the September 17, 2007 meeting with a change in categories for the first two items. All substances approved and submitted to the Board were adopted into rule at the February 2008 meeting.

A Blair has asked that the application be changed to clearly require supporting documentation that application must show qualification.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION: Kevin Wilson asked the council to consider submitting a request to the Board that the formulary law be changed legislatively to do away with or at least make it more reasonable to include substances that are within the best practice of patient care. He feels there is a move towards the elimination of the FC; getting to more inclusive formulary for the profession. He believes the Pharmacists would be supportive of this type of change. Currently a ND is limited in his treatment. R. Marinelli shared that WA has an open Formulary, with a few restrictions.

Discussion continued on asking the Board to consider a Legislative Concept allowing more inclusive prescriptive authority for all NDs. Dr. Wilson noted the list of drugs now on the formulary is an indication that the Board is moving towards a more complete listing. Constituents must be involved before any changes could be made. D.K. moved; A. B. seconded; all are in favor of asking the Board for this consideration. He will write a letter to the Board with this request.

Phil Donovan, Lobbyist for the OANP, stated support from the professional association and a willingness to assist in any way possible.

Nicotine will be moved to Smoking Cessation.
