The Oregon Board of Optometry (hereafter “Board”) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining Optometrists in the State of Oregon. Johnathan Rogers, (hereafter “Respondent”), is not currently licensed by the Board to practice as an optometrist in Oregon and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.

1.

It is alleged from January 2007 to June 5, 2007, Respondent engaged in the unlicensed practice of optometry by offering eye examinations, by refracting patients and providing diagnosis and treatment in the human eye at a business entitled Hub Optix located at 7367 SW Bridgeport Road, Tigard, Oregon. This conduct occurred while Respondent was not in possession of a current and valid Oregon license to practice Optometry. Respondent has not applied for an Oregon optometry license.

2.

The Board alleges that Respondent has been practicing optometry without a valid Oregon license. If proven, these would be violations of ORS 683.180(7), 683.020, and OAR 852-10-025(2)(b). The Board investigator received an eye examination by Respondent at the above location on June 5, 2007. Respondent also admits to providing approximately 50 to 60 eye examinations in the past five months in Oregon.

Temporary Stipulated Order

3.

In order to address the Board's concerns for public safety, Respondent and the Board agree to the entry of this Temporary Stipulated Order, which provides that Respondent shall comply with the following conditions:

- 1) Respondent will cease and desist from performing any optometry services in any way in the State of Oregon, including all services as defined in ORS 683.010 and will notify the Board of his current location including telephone and address.
- 2) Respondent will cease and desist from referring to himself, either orally or in writing as an O.D. and/or optometrist licensed in the State of Oregon. Respondent agrees to correct any written materials that claim he is an optometrist and provide copies of that to the Board.
- 3) Respondent understands that if he violates this agreement, it could subject him to further penalties under ORS Chapter 683.

4.

This order is issued by the Board pursuant ORS 683.180(7), 683.020 and OAR 852-060-025(2)(b). For the purpose of making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the conduct of the Respondent, and to protect serious risk of public safety and competency in the practice of optometry in the State of Oregon, the Board and Respondent agree to enter into this agreement. Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure. This order, however, is a public document.
