1) Licensure

115 new applications have been received and 61 licenses have been issued in 2016. There are currently 208 active applications- including 75 practicing residents. There are 1,898 licensees: 1,525 active, 195 semi-active, 175 inactive, 2 suspended, and 1 on probation.

2) Consumer Protection

50 complaints have been filed in 2016. There are currently 30 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 20 licensees, 2 applicants, and 8 unlicensed practice cases. There are 3 contested cases, and 3 cases on appeal.
