# Support community and economic development which includes:


- Attracting, retaining, and expanding businesses

- Leveraging private, public, and philanthropic resources


**Regions** – Teams – Committees

Regions are strategically aligned with the 11 federally designated economic



Regions – Teams – Committees

- 11 Regional Solutions Teams (RSTs)
- Each RST: Includes five core state agencies and a coordinator
- The role of the team is to make things happen













Regions – Teams – Committees

Five key members appointed by the Governor:

- 1. Convener
- 2. Private Sector Representative
- 3. Philanthropic Representative
- 4. A member recommended by AOC
- 5. A member recommended by LOC

Additional members added by these appointees.

Regions – Teams – Committees

The role of the committees is to...

- 1. Establish Regional priorities for community and economic development in the region;
- 2. Assist Regional Solutions coordinators and teams with connecting to local resources; and
- 3. Consider, review, and recommend regional implementation project proposals.

#### Regional Solutions Program: Outcomes

Community and economic development projects that:

- Address regional priorities,
- Involve multiple agencies, and
- Address sustainable goals and objectives

Work plans track agency involvement, expected outcomes, targets, and milestones.



# Mid-Valley Regional Priorities

Marion, Polk, Yamhill

Primary Goal: Become a center for agri-business innovation and agritourism

- Promote regional workforce development opportunities
- Increase business capital for existing and emerging businesses
- Explore passenger and freight rail opportunities
- Expand agri-tourism opportunities which highlight local produce,
  viticulture/winery operations, and visitor hospitality amenities
- Enhance programs that encourage business retention and expansion
- Engage in local government infrastructure assessments

# Mid-Valley: Quinoa, Transload, Nuts, Wine, Meat, and CTEC

**Project:** Salem-Keizer Career Technical Education Center

**Description:** 150,000 square-foot center that provides regional workforce development opportunities through 10 programs, including Agriscience.

**RS engagement:** Provided Regional Infrastructure Funding, connected center with private and public entities, and facilitated construction/renovations.





# Southern Oregon: GAG and Food

**Project:** Fry Family Food Hub, Jackson County

**Description:** An aggregation, processing and distribution center as well as a commercial kitchen and farm stand.

**RS engagement:** Provided technical assistance on land use issues and Regional Infrastructure Fund resources.





#### Eastern Oregon: Wine, Water, and Reload

**Project:** Milton-Freewater Wine Production Facility

**Description:** A facility to process and bottle wine to enhance and promote the Rocks District American Viticulture Area.

**RS engagement:** Providing technical and resource expertise to the City of Milton-Freewater for the past few years on the concept.





# North Central: Fire

**Project:** Fire recovery in in Wasco, Sherman, and Gilliam Counties

**Description:** This group helped to distribute information through various local networks and over media and arranged well-attended and livestreamed (on Facebook) open house events with resource providers.

**RS engagement:** Convened federal and local partners to make sure farmers were receiving information on crop insurance, federal programs, and other considerations post fire.
