Backyard Biosecurity—It's easy!

Protecting your poultry against disease





6 Simple Steps:

- (1) Keep your distance
 - Restrict access to your property
 - Keep your birds away from other birds
 - Prevent contact with wild birds, especially wild waterfowl



(2) Keep it clean

- Wash hands before and after working with your birds
- Clean and disinfect equipment
- Wear clean clothes
- Scrub your shoes with disinfectant



3 Don't haul disease home

- Buy birds from reputable sources
- Keep new birds separated for at least 30 days
- Clean vehicles and cages



- 4 Don't borrow disease from your neighbor
 - Do not share equipment
 - If you must, disinfect it first



- (5) Know the signs
 - Early detection is critical to prevent the spread of disease
 - Check your birds frequently
 - Do not touch sick/dead birds



- 6 Report sick or dead birds
