Future K Screener Window Open REPEAT

The Future K English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Screener is now available for use. The Future K test window extends from March 1 until December 31 each year. As a reminder, the Future K Screener is for students who will be entering Kindergarten in the coming school year (2023-24). For students who enroll March through June of the 2022-23 school year, use the Grade K Screener.

Early Learning Transition Check-in

ODE and ELD partnered with Oregon's Kitchen Table to engage families and educators around the state who took part in the Fall 2022 Pilot. Over 90 families and 20 educators participated.
