# OSAS Remote Testing Window Opens April 11, 2023 (ELA, Math, Science, and SEED Survey)

The Remote OSAS Testing Window opens on **Tuesday, April 11, 2023**, for all OSAS content areas, including the SEED Survey.

 ELA, Math, Science, and SEED Survey will close on Friday, June 2, 2023.

Remote testing resources are available on the <u>ODE Test</u> <u>Administration web page</u> under the Remote Testing Resources accordion. As a reminder, students who will participate in a remote test session are required to have parental consent for A/V monitoring.

- Once parental consent is obtained, districts need to update the Parental Consent for A/V Monitoring field in TIDE to "Yes, with camera" or "Yes, without camera" on the Student Details Page.
- For summative remote test eligibility, a student must also have the Remote Tester field in the Student Details Page set to "Yes." If the Parental Consent for A/V Monitoring field is left blank or set to "No Remote Testing," the student will not be able to test remotely, even if the Remote Tester field above it is set to "Yes."

### **ELPA In-Person and Remote Summative Test Window Reminders**

The <u>in-person</u> English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Summative test window will close, **Friday, April 7, 2023**.

The <u>remote</u> ELPA Summative test window is open **Tuesday, April 11, 2023**, <u>through</u> Friday, April 28, 2023.

As a reminder, the remote ELPA Summative is a fixed-form test. Each domain of the remote ELPA
 Summative is administered independently, and domains may be administered in any order. Students
 will need the Remote Tester flag set in the Test Information Delivery Engine (TIDE) and Test
 Administrators (TAs) will need the Remote Proctoring permission setting activated in TIDE.

### **OSAS Science Assessment Multi-State Rubric Validation Panel Recruitment**

The Oregon Department of Education is currently recruiting educators to participate in rubric validation sessions for the OSAS Science Assessment facilitated by Cambium Assessment (CAI). Educators interested in participating in reviewing **rubric validation** will make recommendations regarding the scoring of the items and potential adjustments to the rubrics. There is an estimated *4.0 hour time commitment per session*. This panel will meet during the weeks of **May 22 - 25** and **May 30 - June 1, 2023**. This event is fully virtual. ### **ACCOUNTABILITY & REPORTING**

### 2022-23 New School Status Requests due May 1, 2023

Oregon Department of Education annually provides schools an opportunity to request that the Accountability Detail Sheets take into account boundary changes due to modifications to attendance areas, restructuring of schools (e.g., consolidation, separation, etc.), or changes to grade configurations. Schools should use the <a href="Boundary Change Calculator for 2022-23 Accountability Reports">Boundary Change Calculator for 2022-23 Accountability Reports</a> to request New School status if they experience a significant change in student enrollment between school years.

If you feel that it would be appropriate to request New School status, please visit the <u>Accountability Details</u> <u>webpage</u> under the "Tools" menu to access 2022-23 Boundary Change Calculator and other pertinent information.

Please submit required materials for New School Status by May 1, 2023. ODE will respond with a decision concerning the request by mid-June.

### **ELPA Summative Batch 2 Scores Available**

English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) scores from February 2023 (batch 2) are available in the Assessment Record Updating Application (ARUA) on the ODE <u>secure district website</u> and also in the Centralized Reporting System (CRS) on the <u>OSAS Portal</u> as of **Wednesday, April 5**. District Test Coordinators may download or review records in the ARUA to edit accommodation or administration codes (see the <u>Test Administration Manual</u>, Appendix C).
