ELPA21 Batch 3 Scores Available

Scores for students who completed the ELPA21 between March 1 and March 31, 2018 were posted in OAKS Online Reports (ORS) on the <u>OAKS Portal</u> on Thursday, May 3 and also in Student Centered Staging, Accountability Warehouse Extract (AWE), and Secure Assessment Reports 2.0 (SAR) on the ODE <u>secure district website</u> on Tuesday, May 8.

District Test Coordinators may download or review records in Student Centered Staging to edit accommodation, modification, or administration codes (see the <u>Test Administration Manual</u>, Appendix C). **Please note** that there is a one-day lag for changes to test records in Student Centered Staging (district edits or newly loaded records) to be available in the Warehouse applications (AWE and SAR).

OAKS Extended Assessment 2017-18 Test Records Available

OAKS Extended Assessment records for 12th graders (if submitted in the Extended Assessment data entry application by April 26) will be available on **Friday, May 11** in Student Centered Staging, Accountability Warehouse Extract (AWE), and Secure Assessment Reports (SAR) on the ODE <u>secure district website</u>. (If you do not have access to these applications, please contact your <u>district security administrator</u>.)

OAKS Extended Assessment records for all grades will be available in Student Centered Staging, AWE, and SAR on **Friday**, **May 25**.

District Test Coordinators who wish to edit records for 12th grade students who took an OAKS Extended Assessment in 2017-18 may select the Test Type "Extended Assessments" when searching for records in Student Centered Staging. Be sure to resolve errors before downloading or reviewing records online so that the data is as accurate as possible. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Answers to Common Questions from the Field

QUESTION: One of my students opened their Chromebook and was able to see another student's test from an earlier session. I believe the student test that appeared on the screen was due to a different student using the same computer during the previous testing session. How can I make sure this does not happen again?

ANSWER: All Test Administrators (TAs) must ensure that **all** student tests have been paused prior to ending the TA test session to ensure a secure testing environment. TAs can use the pause button on the TA test session screen. The TA pause button is located next to each student's assigned test to pause in cases when the student did not select the pause button on the student screen. For more information on maintaining a secure testing environment, please refer to the guideline within the <u>Test Administration Manual</u>.

QUESTION: Students finished and submitted their tests yesterday, and today TIDE and the Online Reporting System is not reflecting this.

ANSWER: During high testing periods, allow at least 24 hours for TIDE and the Online Reporting System to update. If the system has not updated within 48 hours, please contact your <u>Regional ESD Partner</u>.
