### **ELPA Summative Batch 3 Results Now Available**

The third batch of English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Summative test results are now available in the Centralized Reporting System (CRS). Batch 3 contains scores for students who completed the ELPA Summative assessment from March 1 through April 7, 2023. Results in CRS are unofficial. Official results are found in ODE data applications such as Secure Assessment Reports. ## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

## **Answers to Common Questions from the Field**

**QUESTION:** A student newly enrolled in our district between 4/7 and 5/2 and was determined to have English learner status. According to the Test Administration Manual table 22, this means their ELPA Summative performance counts for English Language Arts in accountability calculations, but by the time the student enrolled, the ELPA Summative window had already closed. What do we do?

ANSWER: See the note on page 34 of the TAM: "For ELPA Summative, whose statewide test window closes before May 1, districts may use administration code 8 for students who enroll after the close of the statewide test window but who are enrolled on the first school day in May."

Assessment administration codes are entered in the ARUA (Assessment Record Updating Application)/ Assessment Test Staging/Assessment Transactional System located in the <u>Central login</u> on the <u>ODE District</u> Data site.
