KINDERGARTEN ASSESSMENT

2017-18 Kindergarten Assessment Materials Issue

ODE has received reports of districts receiving 2016-17 materials intermixed with their 2017-18 Kindergarten Assessment materials. At this time, the full scope of which districts received faulty shipments remains unknown. ODE strongly advises districts to review all Kindergarten Assessment materials to ensure each file (scoresheet, administrator booklet, and student booklet) is for the 2017-18 school year. ODE's test vendor, American Institutes for Research (AIR) is preparing to provide impacted districts with replacement materials. If you discover that your district's shipment included 2016-17 materials, please contact the AIR Helpdesk at 1-866-509-OAKS (6257) or oaks.helpdesk@air.org for assistance. AIR has committed to providing districts with replacement materials within three business days of contacting the helpdesk.

If your district has already administered the Kindergarten Assessment using 2016-17 materials, you will not be required to retest students. Instead, please continue to submit the results through Consolidated Collections following the standard procedure and alert Holly Dalton at holly.dalton@state.or.us that 2016-17 materials were used to inform ODE's validation process.

Oregon Accessibility Manual

The 2017-18 Oregon Accessibilty Manual is now posted. The Oregon Accessibility Manual (OAM) provides districts, schools, and IEP teams policies and requirements that will govern the provision of accessibility supports for students participating in Oregon Statewide Assessments. ESSENTIAL SKILLS

WorkKeys Transition: Impact on Essential Skills

The revised WorkKeys assessment may not be used to meet the Essential Skills graduation requirement pending review by the Assessment of Essential Skills Review Panel (AESRP) and adoption by the State Board. After the updated WorkKeys assessment is released it will need to be evaluated by AESRP to determine its applicability as an Essential Skills assessment option and to recommend achievement standards equivalent in rigor to the other adopted Essential Skills assessment options. AESRP would then need to submit its recommendation to the State Board for adoption. ODE does not anticipate this process being completed before spring of 2018.

The last date for online administrations of the current WorkKeys assessment is **September 30, 2017**. The last date for paper/pencil forms of the current WorkKeys assessment to be delivered to test sites is June 30, 2017, and all materials that need to be scored must be postmarked no later than **August 18, 2017**. This information is also posted on the <u>ACT WorkKeys – News & Announcements</u> page. Note: The revised WorkKeys began being available in June, 2017, so it is important to work with the WorkKeys administrator to ensure that you know which version of WorkKeys is being administered.

Last Day to Make Edits to the Class Roster Collection: September 15

The last day to make changes to your Class Roster Collection will be **Friday, September 15**, and it will not be reopened after this date. If you haven't already done so, please log into your Class Size Validation through the <u>Achievement Data Insight</u> (ADI) to review your data. These data will be published on the front of the <u>school and district report cards</u> and in a <u>standalone report</u>, which will be issued later this fall.

Remember that all sections must be completed in both English and Spanish in order to submit the collection. See the <u>training on April 27</u> for more details. ODE pre-populates "Dear Parents and Community Members" at the top of each letter, and a signature at the bottom – if you need to change the name used in the signature, please contact the <u>ODE Institutions Request Inbox</u>.
