2023-24 Qualified Trainer Webinar Training

MATHEMATICS

Grade 11 OSAS Math Test Blueprint Now Published

Over the coming academic years, all OSAS Math Test blueprints will be aligned with the <u>2021 Oregon Math</u> <u>Standards</u>. Due to the substantial nature of revisions to the high school math standards (i.e., 2+1 model), ODE has published a transitional Grade 11 <u>OSAS Math Test blueprint</u> for the 2023-24 that removes assessment targets and associated items from the item pool that no longer align with Oregon standards. There are no changes to OSAS Math Tests in Grade 3-8 in 2023-24. More details can be found in the accompanying <u>FAQ</u> <u>document</u> and on ODE's <u>Mathematics Assessment</u> webpage.

The Oregon Department of Education Accountability Team discovered that English Learner codes were not set properly for 2022-23 Extended Assessments. This issue has been resolved, and updated assessment data has now been posted in the <u>Achievement Data Insight Application</u>. Answers to Common Questions from the Field

QUESTION: When will the results from the 2022-23 administration of the Alt ELPA be available?

ANSWER: The State Board of Education is expected to vote on adopting cut scores and achievement level descriptors for the Alt ELPA at their October 19 meeting. Once the cut scores and achievement level descriptors are adopted, ODE can start the process of generating and delivering score reports to districts.
