Boys & Girls Club Greater Santiam (BGCGS) 21CCLC program seeks to cultivate a community of caring and belonging that respects all, regardless of background or identity. Our program offers evidence-based curricula and guided activities to facilitate student achievement and progress toward state education standards, positive youth development, supports family engagement in their children's education in school, and connections to community support and resources. The focal populations for our 21CCLC program are students in grades 5-10 at 6 program sites who need academic support to meet state academic standards for grade level in core subjects, students who need intervention or support in social-emotional development, and the families of such students. BGCGS is experienced in offering equity-driven opportunities for learning, enrichment, and social-emotional development that build well-rounded youth. BGCGS follows a quality improvement process to ensure that our 21CCLC program strives to meet program goals and best serves the needs of our students and families. Our program is a consortium of two partner school districts (SD), Lebanon School District 9, Sweet Home School District 55, and multiple community organizations that will serve students from 16 schools across both districts. If funded, BGCGS will serve 290 students in each year of the program.
