The Corvallis School District 21st CLCC Program will consist of after-school academic and social-emotional intervention and enrichment at our four Title I elementary school sites (Garfield, Letitia Carson, Lincoln, and Mountain View). The programs will operate after school five days a week and on site. Additionally, these programs will continue during the summer months. Academic enrichment will be aligned to the school day and Oregon standards and make use of current intervention programs already available in our schools. Categories of reading interventions will include Phonological Awareness, Phonics, Fluency, and Comprehension and address the needs of both our English-only and Spanish dual-language students. Math interventions will align with our instruction using Bridges for Math. Social-emotional enrichment for students will align with our daily elementary SEL instruction and also include STEM, Gardening, and Art instruction as well as movement. The 21st CCLC Program Director will work closely with each building's MTSS staff to ensure that intervention and enrichment are aligned with instruction happening during the school day and to share data back to schools on student progress.
