The Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS) is developing funding opportunities with approximately \$300 million of combined American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding matched with Oregon General Fund. These ARPA project funding opportunities are focused on COVID-19 recovery needs and expanding capacity for home and community-based settings in an equitable way that aligns with the ODDS North Star Statement on Equity.

ODDS has a <u>new webpage</u> with information about the ARPA funding opportunities. When grants are open for application, details will be listed on the webpage. There is also information about grants coming soon and a project plan listing all the funding opportunities. This webpage will be updated regularly.

Our first grant announcement is coming soon.
